When you think of big cities, do you think of trees? Land in big cities is expensive, and most of it is occupied by buildings and concrete. Further, trees need care, which also costs money, and so trees are considered a luxury item.

However, the value of urban trees is underrated. Especially in summer, cities can become uncomfortably hot, as metal and concrete absorb and store heat. (A) Trees help soak up the hot sun, keeping the ground underneath them cooler. They also absorb sound, reducing noise from cars, trains, and people, making cities slightly quieter places.

But there is another thing trees help absorb: pollution. A single tree can absorb 6kg of carbon every year. In 2013, a U.S. study found that urban trees remove enough particulate matter (PM)² from the air to save millions of dollars in healthcare costs.

So why aren't cities planting more trees? One reason is money. City governments pay for planting and maintaining trees, but the money saved in healthcare costs goes to healthcare agencies, not directly to city governments. These agencies could save even more money by providing financial assistance to city governments for planting trees.

(B) In the end, doing so would help make everyone richer and healthier.
