(A) In 2013, Nobu Okada founded Astroscale, a company with a big mission to protect the future of space. Their goal is to build a sustainable space economy. Our Earth is surrounded by an increasing amount of space junk, including old satellites. This space junk is a serious threat to active satellites and space stations.

Astroscale appeared like a hero to tackle this problem. The company is developing an “orbital gripper” to capture old satellites and pieces of space junk, and push them toward the Earth to burn up in the atmosphere. With this gripper they plan to remove a large amount of space junk.

In addition, Astroscale provides various services in space. They extend the life of satellites, inspect and repair broken machines, and prevent satellites from turning into debris after their missions end. (B) These innovative solutions are an important step towards making space safer and more sustainable.

Astroscale’s efforts have been recognized and supported by the governments of Japan, the United States, and the United Kingdom. They not only focus on technology development but also work with many private companies, organizations, and government agencies to create space policies and best practices.

Astroscale's challenge brings hope to the problems we face. 【space, let’s, the Earth, work, our own hands, and, together, to, both, with, protect.】!
